OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 10, 1983, MCI Airsignal, Inc., Washington, D.C. seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide one-way paging service within a 30 mile radius of Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Protests to the application were filed by ATS Mobile Telephone Inc. and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company.

The scheduled public hearing on the application was continued to a date to be later determined pending issuance of a Declaratory Ruling by the Commission.

On November 4, 1983, applicant requested that its application be dismissed.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application be dismissed at applicant's request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that application No. C-362 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
