OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 4, 1983, the Dalton Telephone Company, Inc., Dalton, Nebraska seeks a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, maintain, and operate toll telephone facilities at Dalton and Gurley, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant owns and operates the telephone exchanges at Dalton and Gurley. The Northwestern Bell Telephone Company presently furnishes toll telephone services at said exchanges.

Applicant proposes to purchase, maintain and operate the required toll telephone facilities at its exchanges from said central offices to connect with the facilities of Northwestern Bell Telephone Company as follows:

Applicant proposes to connect the Dalton Central Office with Northwestern's cable facility at a point located in the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, Range 49 West, Township 17 North, Cheyenne County, Nebraska a distance of approximately 1,082 feet.

Applicant proposes to connect the Gurley Central Office with the Northwestern's cable facilities at a point in the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Range 49 West, Township 16 North, Cheyenne County, Nebraska a distance of approximately 1,217 feet.

The Northwestern Bell Telephone Company is agreeable with the application and has filed its consent thereto. Any existing facilities of Northwestern Bell Telephone Company not acquired by applicant will be removed or otherwise deposed of and no duplication of facilities will be created.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-365 be and it is hereby granted and the Dalton Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to purchase, maintain and operate toll telephone facilities at Dalton and Gurley, Nebraska as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to furnish toll telephone service at Dalton and Gurley, Nebraska as set forth in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.
