By its application filed March 7, 1983, the Northeastern Telephone Company, Blair, Nebraska, seeks to sell embedded telephone equipment.

Applicant seeks authority to offer for sale to its customers existing installations of key and PBX systems, telephone sets and auxillary equipment on customer premises. Prices for such equipment will not, under ordinary circumstances, be below net book value.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
