OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 14, 1983, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska seeks approval of tariff sheets of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Section 3, Original Sheets 2 and 3

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to construction charges to establish facility charges for new areas of land development. In such cases the developer will pay a facility charge equal to the cost of extending service to the development, to be refunded over five years as structures are completed. In lieu of such charge, a non-refundable charge of 50% of the cost may be paid or a pro rata charge will apply to individual building occupants as service is established.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-388 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
