OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered July 12, 1983, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company was authorized to revise its tariff relating to construction charges to establish facility charges for new area of land development.

Upon its own motion this Commission hereby reconsiders, vacates and sets aside the order entered July 12, 1983.

Upon further consideration of the application and attending circumstances the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Original Sheets 2 and 3 of Section 3 of applicant's General Exchange Tariff should be modified to apply only the land developments having over five lots and that the application, as so modified is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted as modified.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order entered July 12, 1983 be and it is hereby vacated and set aside and application No. C-388 be and it is hereby granted as modified herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
