OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 18, 1983, Answer Omaha, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska seeks approval of emergency rates for paging services.

Applicant alleges that an emergency exists because of competition by ATS Mobile Telephone, Inc. Applicant further alleges that it will suffer a loss of paging subscribers to ATS Mobile Telephone, Inc. unless it is allowed to file rates immediately.

Applicant proposes the following rates for equipment and for resale of paging services:

Applicant's proposed tariffs containing regulations and rates for paging resale are attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission finds that an emergency does exist as provided by Section 75-121, R.R.S. 1943, and the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that, an emergency having been found to exist, Application No. C-390 be and it is hereby granted and Answer Omaha, Inc., be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein for tone-only and digital paging service.
