OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 15, 1983 ATS Mobile Telephone, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, seeks a Declaratory Ruling concerning the applicability of rules and regulations to resale of paging service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protests was filed.

The application was held in abeyance at applicant's request. Applicant has not responded in writing to a request to proceed with the application.
