OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 9, 1983, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to separate access charges for mobile telephone service and personal page service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant's tariff covering mobile telephone and paging service presently contains rates which combine rental of the unit and access service. It is proposed to separate these rates as follows:
