By its application filed May 10, 1983, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its General Exchange Tariff.

The service permits outgoing toll calls to be limited to collect, third number or credit card. A rate of \$1.50 per month per line is proposed.
