OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 20, 1983, the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska seeks authority to revise its local exchange tariff for Chester, Nebraska and to offer custom calling services.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to establish the following all one party rates at its Chester, Nebraska exchange to be effective upon completion of its upgrading program.

Party line rates will be discontinued and all one party service and touch tone service will be provided.

Applicant also proposes to offer custom calling service including call waiting, call forwarding, three-way calling and speed calling in exchanges where facilities permit.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-400 be and it is hereby granted and the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
