The Commission hereby finds that the staff has conducted an investigation into the alleged availability of intrastate long distance telephone communications services without certification as required by Neb.Rev.Stat. § 75-604 (Reissue 1981), and further that as a result of the staff's investigation there is evidence to show that both Southern Pacific Communications (SPRINT) and MCI are presently providing long distance intrastate telephone communications services without proper authority.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that an investigatory hearing into this matter, pursuant to Rule 9 of the Rules of Commission Procedure, will be held on October 25, 1983, in the Commission Hearing Room, First Floor, State Office Building, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509, at 2:00 p.m., and that representatives of Southern Pacific Communications (SPRINT) and MCI are hereby ordered to appear at said investigatory hearing.
