Applicant seeks to revise its tariffs effective January 1, 1984 to restrict the amount of concession employees receive on their residence telephone service to local service, i.e. dial tone only, and to service charges to establish service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
