By its application filed October 6, 1983, the Clarks Telephone Company, Clarks, Nebraska, seeks authority to sell telephone equipment.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to provide for the sale of new and existing installations of telephone terminal equipment. Sale of existing installations of equipment will ordinarily be at not less than net book value.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
