OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 7, 1983, the Rodeo Telephone, Inc., Burwell, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend certain tariff schedules.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to increase one-time service connection charges as follows: Service ordering charge from \$3.00 to \$5.00; Line access charge from \$4.00 to \$9.00.

It is also proposed to revise mobile telephone rates to establish a rate of \$25.00 per month for central office access and \$45.00 per month rental for a standard unit. Rental proposed for a premium unit providing touch-tone dialing, automatic redialing and other custom features is \$60.00 per month. The present rates for mobile telephone service including both access and rental is \$60.00 per month.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-453 be and it is hereby granted and the Rodeo Telephone, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
