OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 7, 1983, American Radio Communications Co., Ltd., Denver, Colorado seeks a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to operate a wide area domestic public land mobile one way radio paging service in and around Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

On November 23, 1983, applicant submitted a letter requesting that its application be withdrawn.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.
