OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 30, 1983, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to suspend the service order charge for custom calling and touch calling service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to waive and suspend the authorized service order charge applied on custom calling and touch calling service during special periods of not more than 60 days and at the time of central office conversions during the year. The suspension would apply at any offices converted during the one year period.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-479 be and it is hereby granted and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to suspend service ordering charges as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
