OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 27, 1984, ATS Mobile Telephone, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of emergency rates for certain paging services.

The applicant alleges that because of deregulation of paging equipment by the F.C.C. and this Commission and the corresponding low service rates of both regulated and non-regulated pervayors of paging service in Omaha, Nebraska, it is not able to compete under its present rate structure; that it is losing and will continue to see its present customer base eroded on an immediate basis if the equipment rates are not deleted and lower service rates approved by this Commission.

Applicant proposed to reduce its paging service rate as follows:

Direct Dial Interconnected Tone Only Paging Service:

Each unit	\$ 5.00
Phone number charge	.80
Total	<u>\$ 5.80</u>

Direct Dial Interconnected Digital Paging Service

Each unit	\$ 8.00
Phone number charge	.80
Total	<u>\$ 8.80</u>

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission finds that an emergency does exist as provided by Section 75-121 R.R.S. 1943; and the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an emergency having been found to exist that application No. C-486 be and it is hereby granted and the equipment rates are deleted from its tariff and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein upon filing its tariff sheets as attached to its application.
