OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 31, 1984, the Three River Telco, Lynch, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend its tariff schedules.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

General Rules and Regulations, Sheets 8, 8A and 9.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer for sale or to offer to transfer through capital credits existing installations of telephone equipment. Any such transfer would be optional with the subscriber.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-487 be and it is hereby granted and the Three River Telco be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
