OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission is aware that the rate for local calls from coin telephones varies among the telephone companies in Nebraska.

In order to promote uniformity of rates, a public hearing should be scheduled to consider the following:

That all telephone companies operating in Nebraska file revised tariffs establishing a rate of 20¢ each for local calls from coin telephones, except that companies whose coin telephone rate is now higher than 20¢ need not reduce said rates.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a public hearing be held on March 19, 1984 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska to consider the adoption of a general order establishing the rate of 20¢ for local calls from coin telephones for all telephone companies in Nebraska except those where coin telephone rate is presently higher than 20¢.
