OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By supplemental application filed June 25, 1985, Millicom Information Services, Inc., seeks cancellation of certain authority by restrictive amendment.

By order entered December 5, 1984 applicant was granted authority to render unrestricted one-way messaging service within a 20-mile radius of 1101 South 50th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Currently applicant intends to offer only alphanumeric one-way messaging service and seeks to have its authority so restricted.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the supplemental application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-492, Supplement No. 1 be and it is hereby granted and the authority held by Millicom Information Services, Inc. be and it is hereby restricted in such a manner that it is authorized to provide only alphanumeric one-way messaging service within a 20 mile radius of 1101 South 50th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.
