OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 6, 1984, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to apply a Semi-public telephone installation and station wiring charge.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Fourth Revised Sheet 3A, Section II

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to establish a one time charge of \$12.95 for wiring and station connection of semi-public telephone service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
