OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 20, 1984, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to eliminate 4 party rural service at Riverdale and 4 party urban service at Battle Creek.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to eliminate the offering of residence 4 party rural service at Riverdale and residence 4 party urban service at Battle Creek. There are presently no customers for these services.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
