OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 8, 1984, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks to revise its tariff to clarify calls which are exempt from LMS local usage charges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A protest was filed by Tracy Corp. II.

Public hearing was scheduled to be held on the application whereupon the protest was withdrawn and the matter was processed administratively.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

First Revised Sheet 2.1, Local Exchange Tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to Local Measured Service to indicate that local usage charges will not apply to calls to the telephone company business office, to repair service, to directory assistance, to long distance carrier access trunks or to emergency service numbers.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-508 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
