OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 29, 1984, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks for authority to remove residence two-party urban service at Kearney, Columbus, Albion, Neligh, Madison, Tilden and Franklin and four-party urban service at Columbus, Albion and Ord.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Thirty-eighth Revised Sheet F, Section I

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to discontinue the offering of residential two-party urban service at Kearney, Columbus, Albion, Neligh, Madison, Tilden and Franklin; and to discontinue the offering of residence four-party urban service at Columbus, Albion and Ord, Nebraska. No existing subscribers will be affected.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-519 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
