OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 29, 1984, Great Plains Communications, Inc., Blair, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff covering paging service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks authority to initially offer paging service in the exchanges of Bloomfield and Creighton. Such service would be offered at other exchanges when sufficient customer interest is shown to justify the Applicant to make the required capital expenditure.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference was a copy of Applicant's proposed tariff covering terms and conditions relating to the paging service. Rates proposed are \$10.00 per month for tone only and \$15.00 per month for tone and voice.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-520 be and it is hereby granted and the Great Plains Communications, Inc., be and it is hereby authorized to offer paging service to its subscribers under the rates and regulations set forth in the tariff referred to in the Opinion and Findings which by this reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
