OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 7, 1984, Telephone Answering Bureau, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer paging service as a radio common carrier in Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A protest to the application was filed by ATS Mobile Telephone Inc. but was withdrawn after amendment of the application.

Upon consideration of the application, the evidence adduced at the hearing and being fully advised the Commission is of the Opinion and finds that:

1. Applicant is a corporation with its principal office located at 1010 Northwest Radial Highway, Omaha, Nebraska. It is presently engaged in the telephone answering service business.

2. Applicant originally proposed to provide paging service as a radio common carrier at Omaha, Nebraska. On September 7, 1984 its application was amended to offer paging service in resale only.

3. Applicant proposes to offer tone and voice, tone only and digital pagers through resale of the existing radio common carrier offerings.

4. Applicant has fifteen employees and is staffed 24 hours each day. Financial statements introduced in evidence indicate that applicant is financially able to offer the service proposed.

5. Affidavits of five prospective customers indicate that there is a need for the service proposed by applicant.

6. The application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted as amended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-522 be and it is hereby granted as amended and Telephone Answering Bureau, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to offer paging service in Omaha, Nebraska as a radio common carrier in resale only.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to furnish the service proposed.
