OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 15, 1984, the Arapahoe Telephone Company, Arapahoe, Nebraska, seeks approval of restated tariffs and proposed rates for IMTS service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the proposed tariff.

The proposed tariff consists of: Section 1, General; Section 2, Rules and Regulations; Section 3, Rate Schedule; and Section 4, Long-Distance Toll Telephone Service.

Except as set forth below, the proposed tariff is a restatement of applicant's existing tariff and does not include any changes in rates for existing service.

Applicant also proposes to offer IMTS mobile service at a rate of \$40.00 per month. A charge of \$.10 per minute will apply for each message over three minutes.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-523 be and it is hereby granted and the Arapahoe Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
