OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 15, 1984, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Brainard telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map No. 6 for the Brainard exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Brainard service area to serve P. K. Litt now located in the Ulysses exchange of Clarks Telephone Company.

Affidavits have been received indicating that the application is agreeable to all parties and that no duplication of facilities will be created.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-524 be and it is hereby granted, and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Brainard service area as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant and Clarks Telephone Company file appropriate service area maps with the Commission.
