OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 9, 1984, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to discontinue the offering of IMTS and Paging Service at its Kearney Exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Second Revised Sheet 9, Section IX
Fifth Revised Sheet 13, Section IX

Applicant seeks to discontinue the offering of mobile telephone service and paging service at its Kearney exchange concurrent with the installation of a new digital central office at Kearney, now scheduled for February, 1985.

Applicant presently serves 27 mobile and 8 paging subscribers at Kearney.

Radio Common Carrier service is available at Kearney from Midtown Communications, Inc., which has submitted a letter expressing interest in purchasing applicant's equipment or licensing additional channels to make comparable service available to applicant's existing subscribers.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-528 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
