OPINION AND FINDINGS

By its application filed July 20, 1984, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks to revise its tariff to charge the operator person-to-person rate of \$1.60 if requested to assist in emergency situations which involve a non-published number.

On October 21, 1986, applicant asked that its application be dismissed.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-534 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
