OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 18, 1984, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks to move all mileage rates to the Mileage Charges section of tariff, restate concurrence for interexchange service and clarify the bridged main station service section.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to move all mileage rates from the Private Branch Exchange Service and Private Line Service sections to the Mileage Charges section. Obsolete mileage charges are being deleted. The concurring company statement in the Private Line section is rewritten to clarify that applicant concurs in the Northwestern Bell intrastate intraLATA tariff. The bridged main station tariff is clarified to indicate that it applies to flat rate service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-546 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
