OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 14, 1984, Platte Valley Communications, Grand Island, Nebraska seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

Notice of filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

Pursuant to notice required by law, public hearing was held on the application on February 12, 1985 in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the evidence adduced at the hearing and being fully advised the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Platte Valley Communications is owned by Howard and Carla Nispel and has its principal place of business at Grand Island, Nebraska.
2. It is presently engaged in the sale and servicing of two-way radios and pagers as a contractor for Motorola, Inc.
3. Applicant now seeks to provide mobile radio and paging as a radio common carrier serving subscribers having businesses or residences located within twenty-five miles of York, Nebraska.
4. Applicant has received expressions of interest in the service proposed from 31 individuals.
5. Applicant should be limited to two years in which to have its system in operation.
6. The application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-560 be and it is hereby granted and Platte Valley Communications be and it is hereby authorized to furnish two-way mobile radio and paging service as a radio common carrier to subscribers having businesses or residences located within twenty-five miles of York, Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide the service authorized herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted herein shall expire two years from the date of this order in the event that applicant has failed to operate the service proposed, unless the Commission has, for good cause shown, granted an extension of time.
