By its application filed December 28, 1984, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend its General Exchange Tariff.

Applicant seeks to delete from its tariff rates for mobile telephone equipment and pagers. It is also proposed to offer access lines for display and tone alert and display and silent alert pagers. It is also proposed to include Hebron, Nebraska in the Fairbury mobile service area.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
