OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 9, 1985, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks to remove mobile and paging equipment from its tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to mobile telephone service to remove from the tariff rates for mobile and paging equipment in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission decision detariffing such equipment.

ORDER
