OPINION AND FINDING

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 20, 1985, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks to establish rates for customer-provided semi-public telephone service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A protest to the application was filed by AT&T Communications of the Midwest and a public hearing was scheduled on the application. The protest was withdrawn and the application processed under the Commission's modified procedure.

Applicant proposes to revise its tariff relating to semi-public telephone service to provide for customer provided semi-public telephones. The tariff provisions proposed conform to the Commission's Rules and Regulations regarding customer owned semi-public telephones.

Applicant has proposed a rate of \$55.00 per month for customer provided semi-public telephone service which is intended to recover the existing revenue from semi-public service.

The application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-572 be and it is hereby granted and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the Sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
