OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 5, 1985, Omaha Cellular Limited Partnership seeks approval by this Commission of a revision in its Tariff §4.4 pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes, §75-121 (Reissue of 1981). Upon review of the contents of the Application, and being fully advised concerning this matter, this Commission finds that Applicant's Tariff §4.4 should be amended as set forth below in order that members of the general public in the area to which Applicant proposes to offer its cellular radio telecommunications services, can be better informed of the availability of such services and may have the opportunity to obtain access and up to 300 minutes of usage, free of charge, on Applicant's system.

As amended, Section 4.4 of Applicant's Tariff shall read as follows:

Each Cellular Customer which applies for service prior to May 1, 1985, will receive, free of any charge, access and up to 300 minutes of usage during the first full billing period. Tariff charges for all other services and options will apply.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Applicant's Tariff §4.4 as amended and set forth above is hereby approved, to become effective immediately in accordance with §75-121 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, as amended,
