OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 11, 1985, Satellite Business Systems seeks to offer intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Protests to the application were filed by AT&T Communications of the Midwest, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company and General Telephone Company of the Midwest.

A hearing scheduled on the application was continued to a date to be later determined as a result of an amendment to the application filed November 5, 1985. The amendment followed an agreement by MCI to acquire Satellite Business Systems from International Business Machines Corp.

On April 17, 1986 applicant submitted a petition to withdraw its application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-582 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
