OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 17, 1985, the AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, seeks to revise its Mesage Telecommunications Service Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A late protest to the application was filed by Tom Evans, Omaha, Nebraska.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer an optional calling plan known as Pro Nebraska, which for a monthly charge of \$10.00 gives customers a 15 percent discount on all dial station intrastate MTS calls. A non-recurring service charge of \$3.00 applies.

Applicant indicates that revenues from the plan will exceed its cost and provide a contribution to Nebraska revenue.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-585 be and it is hereby granted and the AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
