OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 24, 1985, the City Glass Co., Omaha, Nebraska seeks approval of tariffs for resale of cellular service in Omaha, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to resell cellular mobile telephone service in Omaha, Nebraska and has submitted its proposed rates and charges for service which are:

Basic service	19.95 per line per month
Peak usage *	.39 per minute
Off-peak usage **	.15 per minute
Multiple-number plan (10 or more)	17.95 per line per month
Peak usage	.33 per minute
Off-peak usage	.15 per minute
Bulk service plan (50 numbers, 25 additions)	10.00 per line per month
Peak usage	.30 per minute
Off-peak usage	.10 per minute
Economy service plan	7.95 per line per month
Peak usage	.80 per minute
Off-peak usage	.15 per minute

* Peak usage is 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., business days.

** Off-peak usage is 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., weekends and holidays.

In its order in Docket 79-318, the Federal Communications Commission has preempted state certification requirements for cellular communications service and has also detariffed terminal equipment rates.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
