OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 25, 1985, Omaha Cellular Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, a partnership, seeks approval by this radio service. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §75-121 (Reissue 1981), the applicant sought emergency approval on its application. Upon review of the contents of the application and being fully advised concerning this matter, the Commission finds that applicant's proposed rates and charges for the resale of cellular radio service as set forth on the tariff attached thereto should be approved. Approval of the proposed resale tariff will minimize the anticompetitive effects of "headstart" by one competitor. The grant of the emergency rate relief requested herein will encourage competition in the cellular radio telecommunications, which is in the public interest.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that applicant's tariff including rates and charges as attached hereto is hereby approved, to become effective immediately in accordance with Section 75-121 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, as amended.
