OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 3, 1985, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks to establish a Service through Miscellaneous Common Carrier section of its tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Late protest to the application was filed by Tracy Corp. II and was ruled untimely.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Third Revised Sheet 1, Table of Contents  
Eleventh Revised Sheet 2, General Index  
Original Sheets 1 and 2, Section 31

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to establish a separate section covering facilities provided to Miscellaneous Common Carriers (Radio Common Carriers). This service is presently provided under the Special Assembly section of the tariff. No change in rates is proposed.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-591 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
