OPINION AND FINDINGS

By its application filed May 24, 1985, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to offer operator assisted and calling card charging for local calls.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to provide for operator assisted and calling card local calls including collect and bill to third party calls. The same operator and calling card charges that apply to long distance calls will apply in addition to any charges for the local call.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
