## OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order to Show Cause entered October 8, 1986, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, was directed to show cause, if any there be, why the Commission should not invoke its power under Sections 75-125 and 75-140 Neb.Rev.Stat. 1943 as amended.

Public hearing on the Order to Show Cause was held on October 28, 1986 at 2:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska, with appearances as shown.

The Order to Show Cause resulted from Northwestern Bell's failure to submit revised rates as provided by the Commission order entered September 16, 1986 in the captioned application.

On December 23, 1986, the Commission entered an Order Nunc Pro Tunc and an Order Pursuant To Mandate Vacating In Part Prior Commission Order. The December 23rd order settled the issues raised in the Order to Show Cause which should therefore be dismissed.
