OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 13, 1985, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to discontinue mobile telephone service at Columbus, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to discontinue the offering of mobile telephone and personal paging service at Columbus, Nebraska coincident with the December 7, 1985 replacement of central office equipment. The mobile telephone and paging equipment has been sold to Mid-Nebraska Communications, a radio common carrier serving Columbus.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-608 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
