OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 5, 1985, the Great Plains Communications, Inc., Blair, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Hayes Center telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map for the Hayes Center exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Hayes Center service area to serve a radio tower site now located in unserved territory between Hayes Center and the Wallace exchange of Consolidated Telco.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
