OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 3, 1985, the AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of revisions to its Wide Area Telecommunications Service Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to allow for the resale and sharing of Wide Area Telecommunications Service (WATS) in Nebraska.

Subscribers intending to resell such service should be required to first obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from this Commission.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-624 be and it is hereby granted and the AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that subscribers intending to resell WATS first obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
