OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 16, 1985, the Platte Valley Communications, Inc., Grand Island, Nebraska, seeks approval of the acquisition of a portion of the assets and mobile service business of Charles P. Oden, d/b/a Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest was filed.

Applicant is a Nebraska corporation with its principal place of business at Grand Island, Nebraska. It is engaged in the sale and servicing of two-way radio and pagers at Grand Island, Nebraska and has been issued a Certificate of Con-venience and Necessity to operate as a radio common carrier at York, Nebraska.

Applicant and Charles P. Oden, d/b/a Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems have entered into an agreement for the purchase by applicant of that part of Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems business in Grand Island consisting of the automated portion of the mobile telephone business as described in the agreement attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference. Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems will continue to operate its manual mobile business and radio paging business at Grand Island.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-628 be and it is hereby granted and Platte Valley Communications Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to acquire the automated paging business of Charles P. Oden, d/b/a Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems as set forth in the opinion and findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to applicant for the service authorized herein.
