OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 14, 1986, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to remove mobile telephone and paging service from its tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Applicant seeks to discontinue its offering of mobile telephone and paging service at Scottsbluff, Nebraska. The mobile telephone and paging equipment has been sold to Tracy Corporation II which will operate it along with its radio common carrier operation at Scottsbluff.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-649 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheet set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
