OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 2, 1986, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks to revise its tariff to add the offering of Basic and Enhanced 911 Emergency Number Service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer basic and enhanced 911 emergency number service. Enhanced emergency number service is a telephone exchange communications service whereby a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) designated by the customer may receive and answer telephone calls placed by dialing the number 911. It includes the services provided by the lines and equipment associated with the service arrangement, for the answering, transferring, and dispatching of public emergency telephone calls dialed to 911.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.


