## OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 14, 1986, the Hamilton Telephone Company, Aurora, Nebraska, seeks authority to temporarily waive service charges for touch tone and custom calling services.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to waive certain service charges for touch tone and custom calling service at various times during a one year period beginning on the date of this order.

Charges to be waived are: for touch tone service, the line access charge, central office wiring charge and premise visit charge; for custom calling service, the central office wiring and premise visit charges, and the non-recurring service charges for call-waiting, call forwarding, speed calling, 3 party conference calling and any 3 or 4 features ordered at one time.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-697 be and it is hereby granted and the Hamilton Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to waive service charges as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
